Revival

As I write this, there is a revival occurring at Asbury University. If you haven't heard, some students started a worship service at a chapel and they felt so moved by the Spirit that it just kept going for several days. That sounds awesome. I don't have any friends currently at Asbury so I don't have any first-hand accounts, but it sounds wonderful. I once was a campus minister and anytime college students are choosing worship over the many bad options they have it's a good day. If you believe the research, the statistics say that less than 30% of the younger generations attend church at least once a month. I imagine these students especially have been through a great deal. College should be the most socially informative time of a person's life but for these students, many of them spent those precious years in isolation due to Covid. My prayer is that they experience a true revival of their faiths.

Revival is not an easy thing to understand and an even harder thing to catch. At its core revival is a reigniting of something that somehow is no longer aflame. The fire of our faith can start to smolder to ash if we don't keep stoking and fanning its embers. I have preached at, and attended revivals. I have been to those "thin places" where the veil between heaven and earth seems particularly thin. I have experienced that "heart strangely warmed" feeling where I know God is with me and I know I am loved. Unfortunately, the Holy Spirit is not something we can bottle and re-apply when feeling low. In the history of the greater Church I'm not sure we have ever experienced something like Covid. It has caused almost an anti-revival, a kind of spiritual recession or dormancy. But I know God is not done. I know sometimes when God is all we have, God is all we need. My prayer for those students in Kentucky, for you, and for me is that God will revive us again. As we head through the season of Lent on the way to Easter, I pray for revival.

Ephesians 3:16-19

I pray that, according to the riches of his glory, he may grant that you may be strengthened in your inner being with power through his Spirit, and that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith, as you are being rooted and grounded in love. I pray that you may have the power to comprehend, with all the saints, what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, so that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.






