

A Herd of Elephants

Why do we do what we do? It's hard to figure out the motives of most people. There is a saying, "The Elephant in the Room." It refers to moments when there is a topic that most everyone knows about but no one is mentioning because it would make things awkward or serious. My family and I are leaving Trinity and Prattville and as much as I deny it, and avoid it, the future is inevitable. We have loved it here and are thankful for all the love.

Take a moment and imagine an elephant in the room with you now. Awesome. Once upon a time I was blessed to go to Zimbabwe on a mission trip and visit an elephant orphanage. Elephants are majestic creatures and as you can probably guess, really hard to miss. Seriously awkward things have happened to all of us in our past, and they can be like that elephant but not so majestic or awesome. Sometimes all we can do is just continue on as if the elephant never happened. It's not really good news but hopefully we find solace in the idea that everyone has their own elephants. They might be so busy trying to ignore theirs that they don't even notice yours. There are occasions where we need to face our elephants and ask them nicely to leave the room.

The great philosopher of my childhood, Mr. Rogers once said, "What can be mentioned can be managed." The Bible warns: *Matthew 10:26 "So have no fear of them; for* nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become *known.*" There is a herd of unseen elephants from all of our pasts running through our lives. We need to step out in faith and face our elephants.

Like a giant invisible elephant, our church faces an uncertain future. For fear of things outside the church we might just change our church internally. I would argue if it isn't broken why are we working so hard to fix it? The Bible says again and again to "Fear not." Trust in God and love one another. YOUTH MINISTRY NEWS




Thank You

Aid to Inmate Mothers (AIM) Inc. was founded in 1987 by Church Women United, The Alabama Prison Project, The Alabama Department of Corrections, and a group of committed volunteers who discovered that there were many women in prison who never saw their children.

AIM's mission is to provide services to Alabama's incarcerated women with emphasis on enhancing personal growth and strengthening the bonds between inmate mothers and their children.

"Pack a Purse" is a mission project dedicated to helping the women who are being released from prison get back on their feet. This ministry provides a new bag/purse stuffed with personal care items and encouraging letters for these women. This is a great opportunity to show love to people who need it and help them find a path to God and a future with Him.


