Rev Ed Said...

Let there be peace on earth is a good thing to sing about.

As we enter the Christmas season the phrase "Peace on earth" will be heard in song or spoken. Yet, it seems other attitudes and crusade themes take higher priority.

"For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace." (Isaiah 9:6) If we submit to the authority of "The Prince of Peace," our anxiety and anger subsides. Turmoil that fuels hatred comes from those who dislodge Christ from his position of Prince of Peace. We are in danger of seeking the peace that follows an offensive to get our way. Yes, our activity becomes the main culprit of robbing us of peace.

"Don't quarrel with anyone. Be at peace with everyone, just as much as possible." (Romans 12:18) I have said that the tone of your voice and your attitude are of greater concern than the topic of your discussion. "Quietly trust yourself to Christ your Lord, and if anybody asks why you believe as you do, be ready to tell him, and do it in a gentle and respectful way." (1 Peter 3:15)

In other words, let Messiah Jesus manage your life. Be like the Prince of Peace in the way you converse with others. Jill Miller composed a well-known folk song with her husband Sy.

"When I attempted suicide and I didn't succeed," Jill said, "I knew for the first time unconditional love—which God is. You are totally loved, totally accepted, just the way you are...and I knew I was here for a purpose."

"Let there be peace on earth, and let it begin with me; let there be peace on earth, the peace that was meant to be. With God our creator, family all are we. Let us walk with each other in perfect harmony."
