
Rev Ed Said...

Spiritual Warfare Training Urgent and Vital

With all the dire situations around the world and in the church, some believe "the signs of the time are everywhere." One fellow said, "The tribulation is here, and my neighbor is the Antichrist!" Poor guy is really having a bad day perhaps.

Next month we begin our Wednesday night Bible studies. I will offer training in spiritual warfare. Why? Too many churches are not knowledgeable of how to use the Armor of God, and Satan is gaining ground in demonic attacks against the church.

My main resources for preparation will be prayer, guidance of the Holy Spirit, Scripture, and Chip Ingram's book *The Invisible War*. We will also find a spiritual warfare song or hymn to share each week. Help me by searching for one to share. For example, "Keep on the Firing Line" and "A Mighty Fortress is Our God." We will see you September 4th!


Our youth sit together on Sunday mornings during the 9:40 service and then attend Sunday School together at 11am. They are working through the book of Psalms in August.


