Ecclesiastes 4:9-10: "Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up."

November is the month to give thanks. The United States holiday of Thanksgiving is generally understood to be inspired by the harvest feast celebrated by the citizens of Plymouth Colony (later known as pilgrims) and the Native Americans of the Wampanoag Confederacy in the fall of 1621.

What is fascinating to me about the pilgrim's story is the importance of an Indian named "Squanto." To make a long story short, this native American had previously been kidnapped and taken to Europe. After acquiring his freedom in England, Squanto returned to America to find his tribe gone and he was basically kidnapped by another tribe.

The similarities with the story of Joseph taken into slavery to eventually be in Egypt to help many is intriguing. For it was Squanto that had mastered the English language to interpret between the pilgrims and local Indians. The Pilgrims learned how to survive from the Indians because Squanto was there to open up an avenue of communication.

God often brings us through hardships to be at the right place to serve a vital purpose in others' lives. Thank you for being a friend in faith. 
Snack Donations


Wednesday Night Supper and Studies
