Rev Ed Said...

If You're Not Humble, You Will Stumble

A popular song from my 1970's high school days was recorded by Mac Davis. "Oh Lord, it's hard to be humble when you're perfect in every way. I can't wait to look in the mirror cause I get better lookin' each day." Every time I heard that song, I just had to snicker.

In our Man Cave Group, we recently read in Matthew chapter 16:11 about Jesus warning the disciples, "But be on guard against the yeast of the Pharisees and Sadducees." Do remember the "I Love Lucy" episode where she put too much yeast in the bread? The large loaf burst out of the oven! The bread spread out of control!

Most of our present troubles come from "a lack of humility" in both society and church. Yeast can be a beast! Promotion of self has replaced adoration of Christ. What does "leaven" or "yeast" do? It puffs up the bread to expand it. The bread has air pockets, and the content is not solid. It appears larger than it actually is. Unleavened bread is solid from the outer layer to the core: what you see is what you get.

So, the yeast of our troubles is "the lack of humility." Humility is defined as "the quality of having a modest view of one's value or importance." The Apostle Paul nailed it in Philippians 2:3-4, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."

People think they are above others and even know more than God. They remind me of those frill-neck lizards running around. They are ugly! And we have the same ridiculous atrocious appearance when we fail to listen to the Lord and genuinely care for the welfare of others.

We must pull the emergency brake! Let the Master Mechanic Jesus tune our engine, accelerate in adoration to Christ, yield to the Holy Spirit, and lookout for others along life's highway.

You can't get to "love" unless you have humility. Listen to the wisdom and concerns of those around you. Stop puffing up with pride and pleasure. Start praising the Lord of All in submission. "Humble yourselves before the Lord and He will lift you up." (James 4:10) A lot of folks need a shot of this 4/10.
