Beware the Eyes of March

As a young lad I misunderstood the phrase "The Ides of March." I thought they were saying, "The Eyes of March." Of course, I was too busy reading my "Mad" magazines to peruse William Shakespear's classic "Julius Caesar" where the phrase "Beware the Ides of March" became a popular quote to basically forewarn everyone to be alerted to pending danger.

It is said that Caesar, the Roman general and dictator, received a similar message on March 15, 44 B.C. He did not take the warning to heart and was assassinated by a group of senators. I could attempt to explain all this as it associates to the Roman calendar but let me say "Ides" refers to the middle of the month. Where is Rev Ed going with these Ides or eyes? Caesar did not heed the warning and just continued with his day without taking any precautions.
