Easter reminds us that Jesus is the One who directs our spiritual lives. We have religious leaders who claim to be enlightened by the Spirit on a new better way of being the church or living the Christian life. However, friends your soul is surrendered to your Redeemer and the Holy Spirit guides you to God's truth.

I have a Methodist Hymnal printed in the year 1889. It is so old that it is "words only" without musical notation. I found a hymn composed by Samuel Medley "He lives, to bless me with his love; He lives, to plead for me above; He lives, my hungry soul to feed; He lives to help me in time of need. He lives, and grants me daily breath; He lives, and I shall conquer death; He lives, my mansion to prepare; He lives to bring me safely there."

What a wonderful reminder that Christ alone takes care of our every need on earth. Jesus will lead us to our place prepared for us in Heaven. I shall submit to one authority in my spiritual life, Jesus. I know that you are proclaiming the same testimony.

"He lives, all glory to his name; He lives my Savior, still the same; What joy the blest assurance gives. I know that my Redeemer lives!" This closing verse from Medley's hymn makes me want to shout what Easter is all about! Christ is risen! But greatest of all Jesus has risen in your soul to give you strength to overcome adversity in this world!

"What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else?" (Romans 8:31-32, New Living Translation)

So, many of you at Trinity Prattville Church continue to holdfast to Jesus alone as you live out your faith. As we refuse to compromise on God's Holy Word and we will not embrace false doctrine, we are only driven closer to Christ. May this Easter remind us that Jesus is alive among us, and we trust him with everything else before us.

Blessings are everywhere. Even in an old antique hymnal with an obscure composer from many years ago yet it gives guidance and strength for us today.


